Redeemer of Israel Lyrics Art

How to Play:

- Sing through Redeemer of Israel once before starting this activity.
- Exclaim wow! There are a lot of big words in this song! Do you know what some of those big words mean? Let's talk about them! To help us understand a word we can use other words to help explain what the keyword means.
- Introduce your first keyword Redeemer. Does anyone know who our Redeemer is? What is a "Redeemer"? Are there other words you can think of to help us understand that word? You can let older kids come up and write on the poster words that make them think about Jesus as our Redeemer. For younger kids, just introduce a few alternate words and talk about the meaning. Such as "someone who saves us". You can also post the chart with the already filled in alternate words that help give context to the keyword.
- Sing through the song and ask for the kids to look for a BIG WORD that you can do next! Let them popcorn out answers until you
 hear the next big word and work through the song in order.

Synonym Ideas:

- Redeemer Savior, Saves Us, Liberates, Rescues, Jesus Christ, Brother, Friend, Shepherd
- Delight Joy, Pleasure, Thrill, Happy, Glee, Smile, Service, Blessed
- Blessing Miracle, Good things, Dedicate, Consecrate, Healing, Comfort, Prayer, Family
- Shadow Always with Us, Protects from heat, Spirit, Shade, Follows Us, Walks with Us, Best Friend
- Pillar Tower, Rock, Column, Support, Mast, Strengthens, Lifts Up, Helps, Carries our Burden
- Deliverer Release, Brings Us to Safety, Helps Us Escape Danger, Provides a Way, Miracles, Pathway, Opens a Door


Extension Activities:


- Pick a word from the keyword page to substitute in for each of the main words. Such as sing "Savior" instead of "Redeemer" or "Miracle" instead of "Blessing". Just swap out one word each time through after introducing some of the alternate words. How does changing the word affect the meaning? Does it help you think deeper about the song and what it's saying?
- Substitute out all the red words, now all the green, etc! Or have half the room sing the colored substitute words and the other half sing the original words. Which one can you hear the loudest and clearest (encourages singing loud, but not shouting!)
- Accept the words in any order, then have them help you sort them back into the correct sequence when you've added all 6!
