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STICK PULL

Materials Needed:

Stick or Broom



How to Play:

- Have 2 children sit across from each other, knees bent and feet touching.
- 2. Place a broom or stick between the two players.
- 3. Have both children hold the stick with both hands.
- 4. When you say, "Go!" each child will try to pull the stick toward them.
- 5. The child who pulls the other up is the winner!

BUTTONS

Materials Needed:

 Button or other small object (penny, dime)

How to Play:

- I. Have all players sit in a circle.
- 2. Choose one player to be "It" and leave the room.
- 3. While the player is gone, the remaining players choose someone to hold the button.
- 4. When the player returns, all children put their hands behind their backs.
- 5. The player guesses who is holding the button!



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
